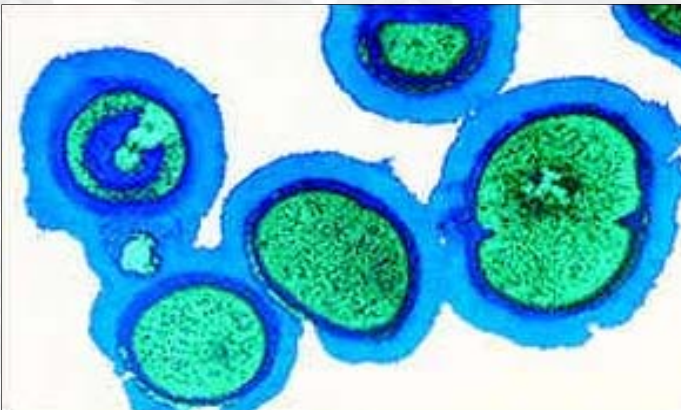


The increase in MRSA infections has been widely reported.
